## Parallels between John and Elijah

Herod $\rightarrow$ Ahab	Herodias $\rightarrow$ Jezebel	John → Elijah
Descended from a line of wicked rulers	Deep hatred/resentment for the man of God	Strange manner of dress
Father was known as the most wicked and violent ruler to date	Reputation for open sinfulness	Close association with the wilderness
Married to a wicked and strong-willed wife who is the one really in charge	A foreigner who rules God's people via marriage	Bold and brave declarations of the sinfulness of the ruler
Listens to the man of God	Known for manipulation of husband/ruler	Suffered a momentary loss of faith following a great spiritual triumph
Fears the man of God	Life ended in disgrace	Received direct encouragement from the Second Person of the Trinity

John the Baptizer	Jesus of Nazareth
Supernatural conception	Supernatural conception
Consecrated from the womb	Consecrated from the womb
Preached message of repentance	Preached message of repentance
Bold declarations of the <i>sinfulness</i> of the religious elite	Bold declarations of the <i>hypocrisy</i> of the religious elite
Tremendous response to his preaching and baptism	Tremendous response to His <i>teaching</i> and mighty works
Feared by the <i>Tetrarch</i> who executed him	Feared by the <i>Roman governor</i> who executed Him
Executed as the result of a manipulative wife	Executed as the result of manipulative religious leaders
Executed in a humiliating manner	Executed in a humiliating manner
After death, body retrieved and buried by disciples at their own risk	After death, body retrieved and buried by disciples at their own risk

<sup>4</sup> ..if anyone utters with his lips *a rash oath to do evil or to do good*, any sort of rash oath that people swear, and it is hidden from him, *when he comes to know it, and he realizes his guilt in any of these;* <sup>5</sup> *when he realizes his guilt in any of these and confesses the sin he has committed,* <sup>6</sup> he shall bring to the LORD as his compensation for the sin that he has committed, a female from the flock, a lamb or a goat, for a sin offering. And the priest shall make atonement for him for his sin.

### JOSHUA 9:14-16

<sup>14</sup> So the men took some of their provisions, but *did not ask counsel from the LORD.* <sup>15</sup> And Joshua made peace with them and made a covenant with them, to let them live, and the leaders of the congregation swore to them. <sup>16</sup> At the end of three days after they had made a covenant with them, they heard that they were their neighbors and that they lived among them.
